THREE OF THE CITY'S MOST ASTUTE COLLECTORS HANDICAP THE 2015 DALLAS ART FAIR. HERE'S AN EXPERT-GUIDED TOUR OF THE CAN'T-MISS EXHIBITORS.

The 2015 Dallas Art Fair marks its seventh distinguished year, with nearly 100 galleries and dealers from 22 cities around the world joining the festivities. From the Preview Gala April 9 to the festival's completion April 12, there's certainly a lot to absorb at the Dallas Art Fair. We checked in with three renowned local collectors—Alden Pinnell, Becky Bruder and Christen Wilson—to get a list of the must-see artists. Listen and learn. dallasartfair.com

Becky Bruder

"I am curious to see what the attention-getting French gallery Galerie Perrotin is going to bring to Dallas. I am also a Jack Pierson fan, and Michele Maccarone currently has an exhibit of his photos. And Washburn Gallery is thriving with American abstract artists of the '30s and '40s, abstract expressionists and the Stieglitz Group." Bruder's other essentials include Derek Eller Gallery, Christian Berst Art Brut, James Fuentes and Massimo de Carlo.

"Must-see galleries are Maccarone Gallery, Jonathan Viner, James Fuentes, Luce Gallery, RaebervonStenglin, HUS Gallery, Galerie Perrotin, Massimo De Carlo, Misako & Rosen and Martos Gallery. Get to the fair as soon as you can—walk all the booths; meet the gallerists; make relationships; and when you see something you like, don't wait to commit or you may lose it." Wilson will be keeping an eye on artists Kika Karadi, Paul Lee, Andrew Dadson, Jess Fuller, Landon Metz, Hugo McCloud and Despina Stokou, among others.

"There are a lot of great galleries at this year's Dallas Art Fair. In addition to visiting your friends from the local galleries, I recommend the following galleries from out of town: Maccarone Gallery, Massimo De Carlo, the Green Gallery, CANADA, Martos Gallery, Marlborough Chelsea, Galerie Perrotin, Jonathan Viner, James Fuentes and Jessica Silverman Gallery. Also, I recommend doing a little online research before you go. ... At the end of the day, your goal should be to have fun."
